I'm sure a lot of you will recognise them because they were the champions in in the Double Championship of the last series of "ONE MAN AND HIS DOG", and if you remember Gell answered calls in Welsh and Bracken whose mistress is English, answered in ~~English~~, and their owner Glyn Jones, who was the champion in the Doubles. Glyn you've got a young dog there, one I don't recognise at all, what's his name.

GLYN: Well he's called Glen and he's just twelve months old.

PHIL: So he's completely untrained. These two we've seen as wonderful trained dogs putting up a superb exhibition last time - how do you train a dog like that?

GLYN: I'll have to correct you we don't train them we actually teach them, and Glen actually hasn't had any lessons up to now.
